Transition Tasks (word document called 'Psychology year 11 transition tasks')

<u>Task 1</u>: Areas and Perspectives in Psychology - Research the different areas of psychology listed on the document, try to get at least three facts for each of the areas. Try to find out what type of behaviour the area investigates and whether you think the area is useful in the real world or not?

<u>Task 2:</u> Research Methods - Listed are the main ways to research ideas in psychology. Your task is to find out as much as you can about these things.

<u>Task 3:</u> Use the links to find as many of the studies we will be looking at over the course and summarise each one is around 150. Try to include: what was being studied, how did they study it, what were the results and what was concluded.
